1. A) who

Who pro osoby v podmětné pozici. The woman WHO lives... = žena, KTERÁ bydlí.

2. B) which

Which/that pro věci. The book WHICH I bought = kniha, KTEROU jsem koupil.

3. C) whose

Whose = jehož/jejíž (přivlastňovací). The man WHOSE car = muž, JEHOŽ auto.

4. D) who

Non-defining clause (čárky!) → who/which, NIKDY that. My sister, WHO lives... = moje sestra, KTERÁ žije.

5. A) where

Where = kde/kam (pro místa). The restaurant WHERE we had dinner = restaurace, KDE jsme večeřeli.

6. B) that

That/who/whom pro osoby. V hovorové angličtině se that používá běžně. Vztažné zájmeno lze i vynechat (the person you were talking about).

7. C) who

Non-defining clause (čárka!) → NIKDY that. Pro osoby → who. I called Tom, WHO didn't answer.

8. D) that

That/which pro věci. V defining clauses (bez čárek) lze that i which. Vztažné zájmeno lze i vynechat.

9. A) who

Who pro osoby v podmětné pozici. The teacher WHO taught me = učitelka, KTERÁ mě učila.

10. B) which

Non-defining clause (čárky!) o věci → which. NIKDY that v non-defining! The Eiffel Tower, WHICH is in Paris...

11. C) why

Why = proč (pro důvod). The reason WHY I was late = důvod, PROČ jsem přišel pozdě.

12. D) who

Who pro osoby v podmětné pozici. The children WHO are playing = děti, KTERÉ si hrají.

13. A) whose

Whose = jejíž (přivlastňovací). The girl WHOSE mother = dívka, JEJÍŽ matka. Whose funguje pro osoby i věci.

14. B) where

Where pro místa. The hotel WHERE we stayed = hotel, KDE jsme bydleli.

15. C) when

When = kdy (pro čas). The day WHEN we first met = den, KDY jsme se poprvé potkali.

16. D) which

Which/that pro věci. The letter WHICH I sent = dopis, KTERÝ jsem poslal. Zájmeno lze i vynechat.

17. A) My brother, who lives in Prague, is a teacher.

Non-defining clause: čárky z OBOU stran + who/which (NIKDY that). „My brother, who lives in Prague, is a teacher.”

18. B) whose

Whose = jehož/jejíž (i pro věci). The house WHOSE roof = dům, JEHOŽ střecha.

19. C) where

Where pro místa. The town WHERE I grew up = město, KDE jsem vyrostl.

20. D) who

Who pro osoby v podmětné pozici. A man WHO could travel = muž, KTERÝ mohl cestovat.
